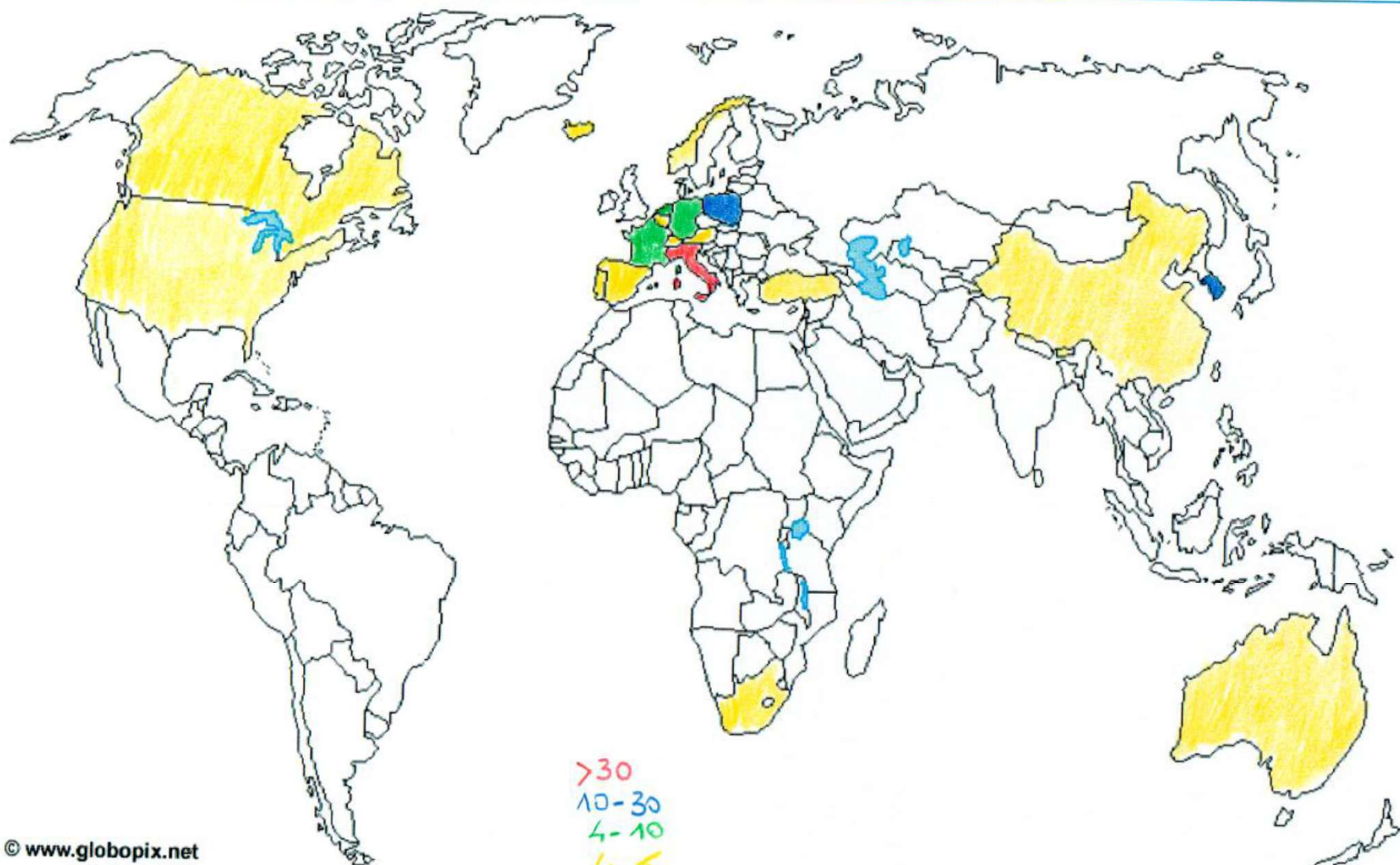

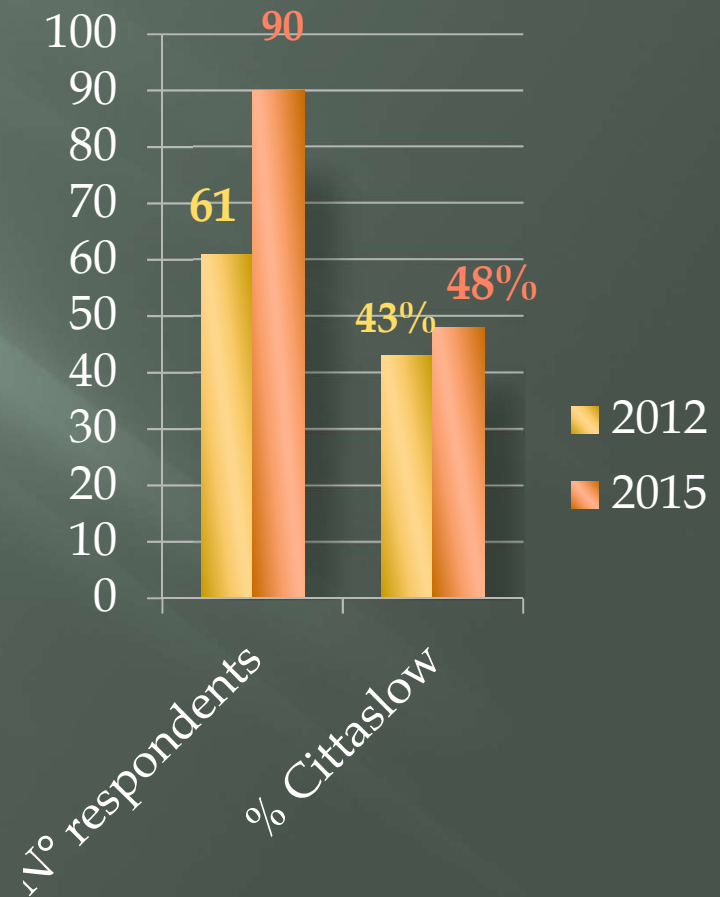
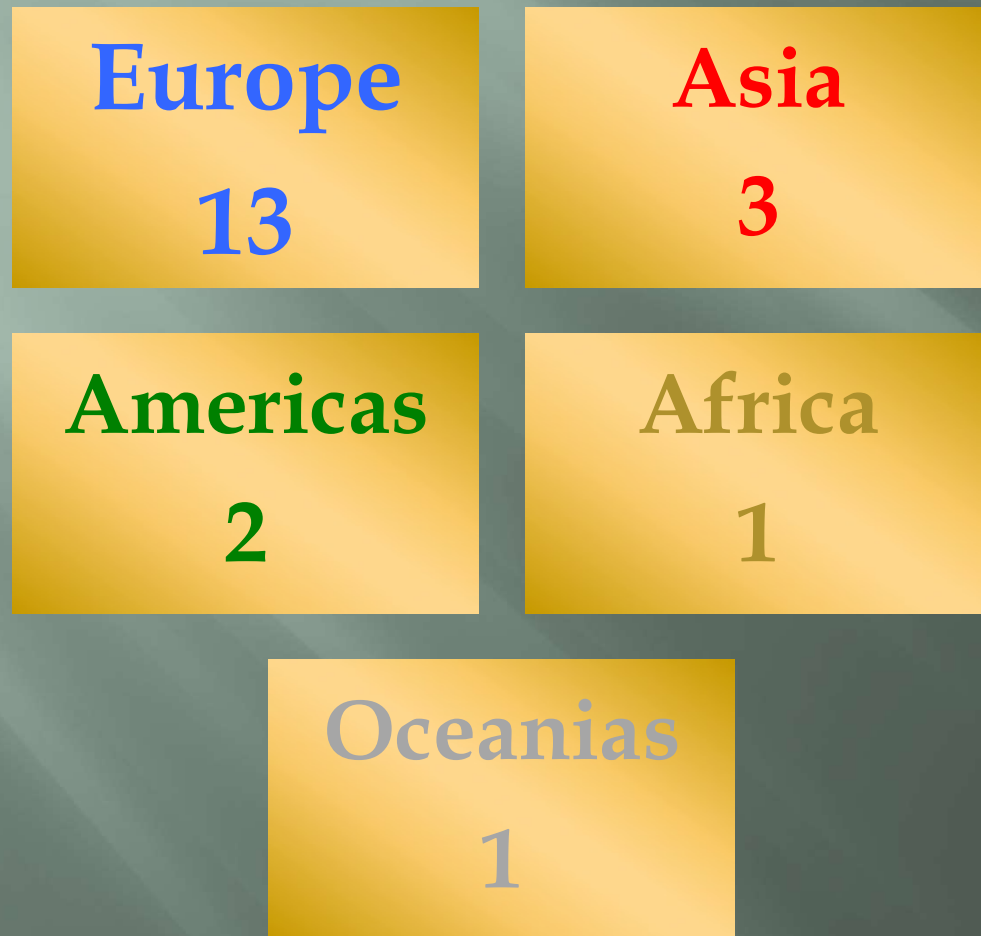

Partecipazione of the 46% of the Italian Cittaslow, 41% of the European, 76% of the Rest of the World

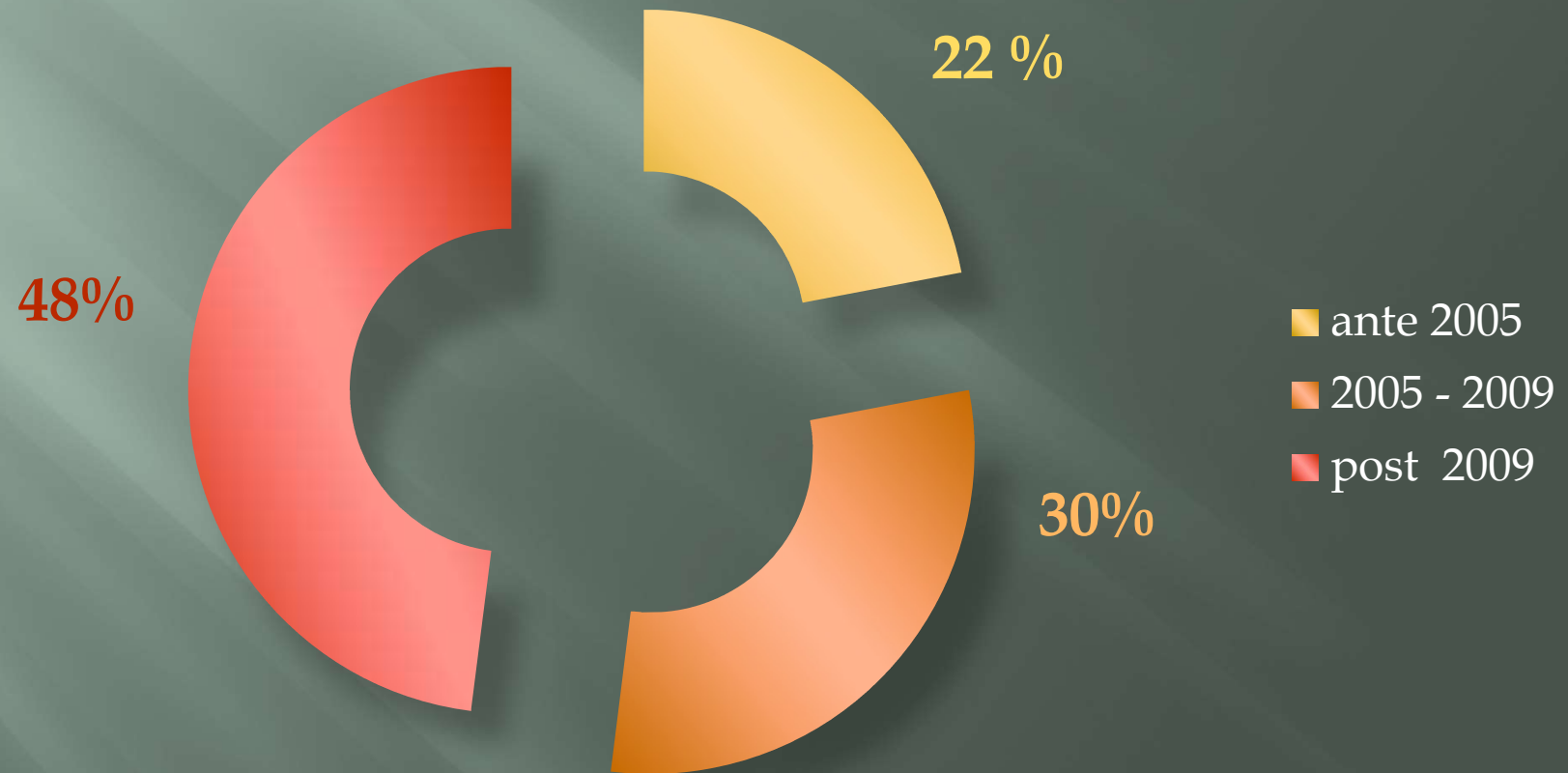

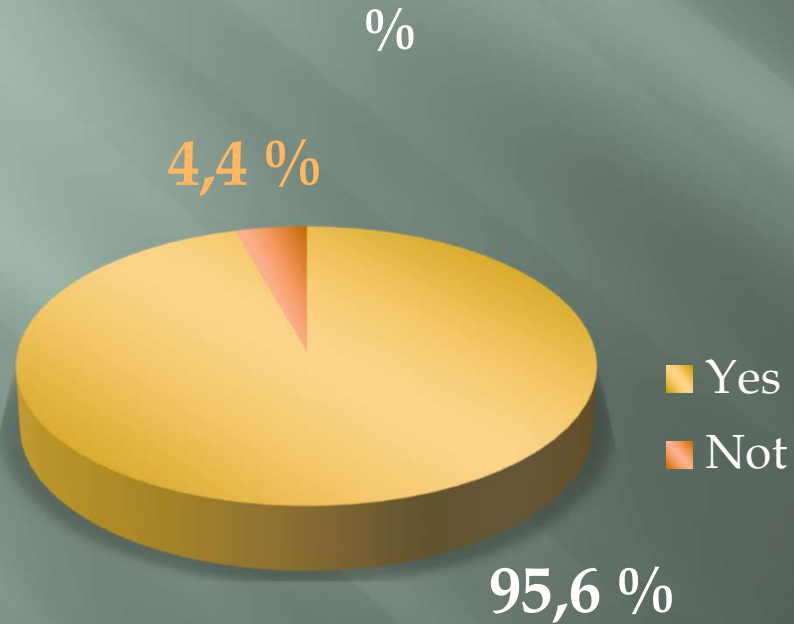

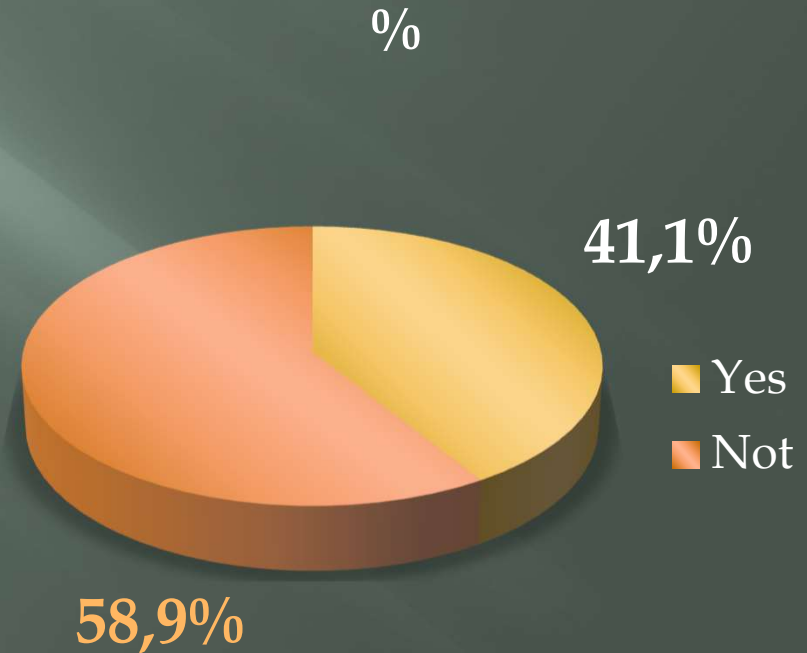

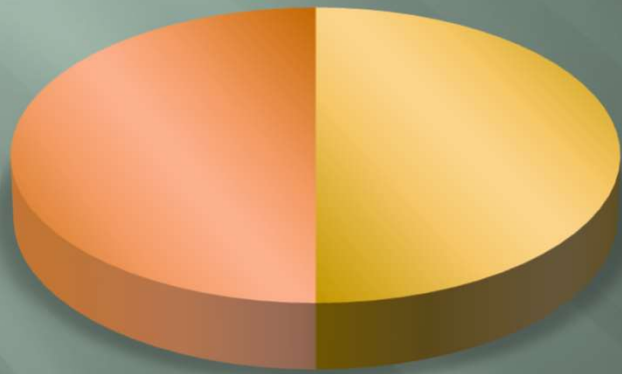
